**76 SENIORS** enrolled in our program



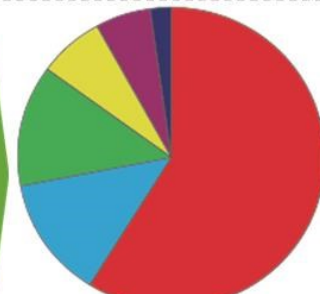
**5,730 MILES TRAVELED** transporting seniors to & from the program & on outings

**76% OF SENIORS** enrolled reported they have made connections with people through Friendly House that they are now in contact with outside of the program



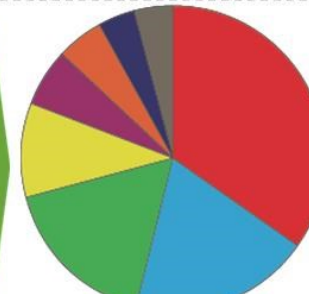
